If your dog is taking Rimadyl, watch for these side effects:

- o vomiting
- o loss of appetite
- o change in drinking habits
- o excessive urination
- o diarrhea
- o regression in house training
- o blood in the stool
- o unusual aggression
- o lethargy
- o wandering in circles
- o stumbling
- o loss of balance
- o jaundice

Any of the above may be a sign of a serious and possibly fatal drug reaction. Stop giving Rimadyl **immediately** and contact your veterinarian. Quick action can save your dog's life.
